### TICKETS & TICKET SALES

- Prom tickets are on sale Monday, May 3 Tuesday, May 11 at <a href="www.schoolpay.com">www.schoolpay.com</a>. You can pay with a debit/credit card or checking account. If you cannot pay electronically, you may pay with cash at the Athletics & Activities Office during lunch or after school. Prom tickets are \$25 per person. Tickets must be purchased in advance. Students in need of a scholarship for a Prom Ticket, please stop by the Activities Office for an application.
- Tickets can only be purchased by students who have no unmet obligations or who have discussed the unmet with the department and been cleared to purchase tickets. The focus is to collect textbooks, uniforms, athletic equipment, and library books. All offices will work with students on payment plans, reduced fees, or scholarships as needed. Cleared lists will be posted on Friday, April 30 by the Activities Office and Media Center.
- Only Richfield High School and RCEP students can attend Prom there will be no outside guests.
- Prom tickets will be sold first to Seniors, May 3-5, then open to Juniors starting May 6.
- Students will be grouped in Pods of 6. To guarantee the Pod, students will need to purchase tickets on the same transaction (i.e. a student collects \$25 from their five friends and pays \$150 at one time and lists themself and five friends on the same transaction). Students who **do not** identify their Pod at the time of ticket purchase will not be guaranteed to be part of a specific Pod; however every effort will be made to accommodate student requests. Students who identify a Pod of less than 6 students may be combined with other smaller pods.
- Students within a Pod will be seated with one another and be able to interact with one another without social distancing. Students must maintain 6 feet of social distancing from students who are not in their identified Pod.
- Students who purchase tickets MUST turn in a **Consent Form** signed by a Parent/Guardian. Consent Forms are due by **Tuesday, May 11 by 4pm**. Consent Forms **must** be turned in by each student; any student without a completed Consent Form will not be able to attend Prom. Completed Consent Forms can be turned into the basket marked PROM 2021 located at the RHS Welcome Desk.

### PROM

- Prom will be held at the Minneapolis Convention Center in Ballroom A. For specific information about the MCC, including directions refer to http://www.minneapolisconventioncenter.com. Parking is available for a fee.
- All students must check-in at the Registration Tables in front of Ballroom A located on the first floor of the MCC. Students may only enter Prom at the designated entrance. Students must present photo identification at check-in. Those without I.D. may be denied entrance into Prom.
- Once you leave the designated area for Prom you may not reenter. Please remember to bring cameras, coats, & other personal items with you into the dance. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Students are expected to follow Covid Safety Guidelines (masks & social distancing will be required) and required to wear a wristband that designates their Pod. In addition, students will need to maintain assigned seats with their designated Pod while not dancing.
- Individuals who do not follow Covid Safety Guidelines or other school policies may be asked to leave. RHS Chaperones, MCC Security & Minneapolis Police will be monitoring student attendees.
- Prom ends promptly at 11:00 p.m. All students must exit the building by 11:15 p.m. Please arrange to have your ride pick you up from the Minneapolis Convention Center by this time.
